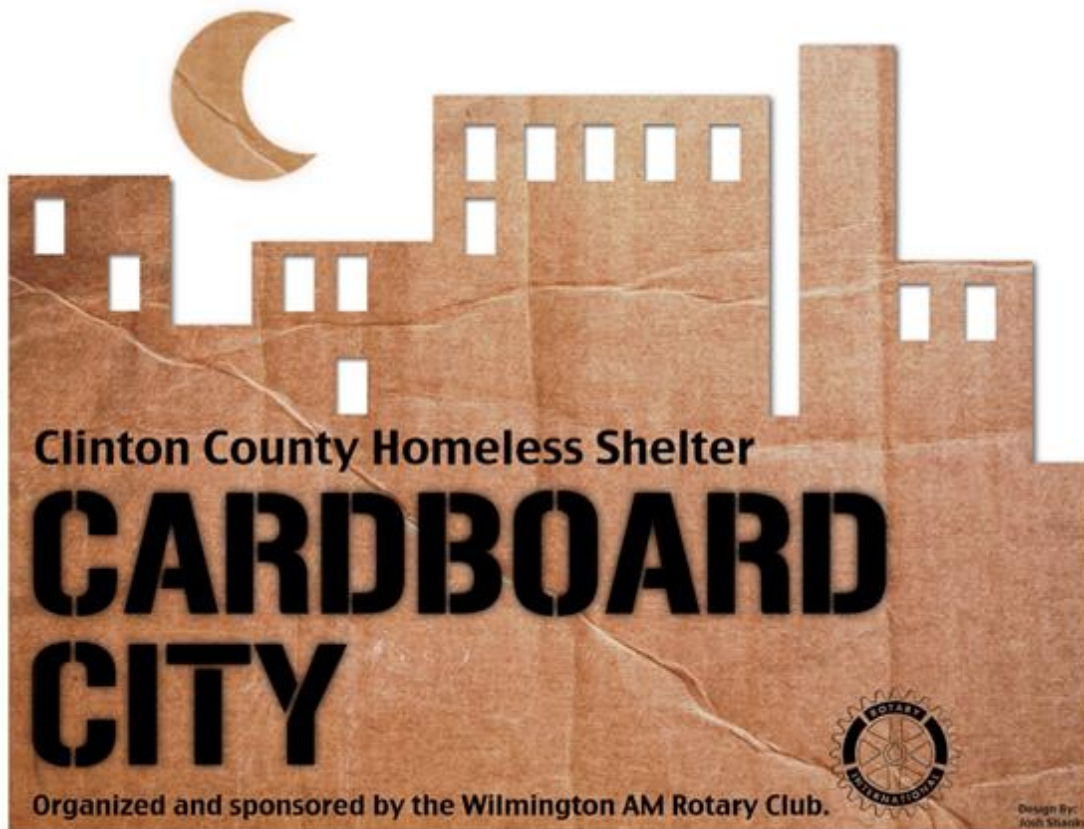

What - Participants will be building houses from cardboard (cardboard will be provided, or you can bring your own) and then sleep in them for a night to gain perspective on what it may feel like to be homeless.

Participants can also build their houses off site and bring it to the event. The structure can be no more than 20' x 20' in size, but creativity is a must; since one individual or team will be awarded the "Most Creative Cardboard Structure" traveling trophy the night of the event!

CARDBOARD CITY is a great team building event for all groups in which you can participate in a community exchange of ideas, goals, and facts.

- "Hands Together for Homelessness" event will be at 7:00 p.m. on the night of CARDBOARD CITY we will see if we can get enough people to hold hands around the entire Clinton County Courthouse block to raise awareness of homelessness in Clinton County.

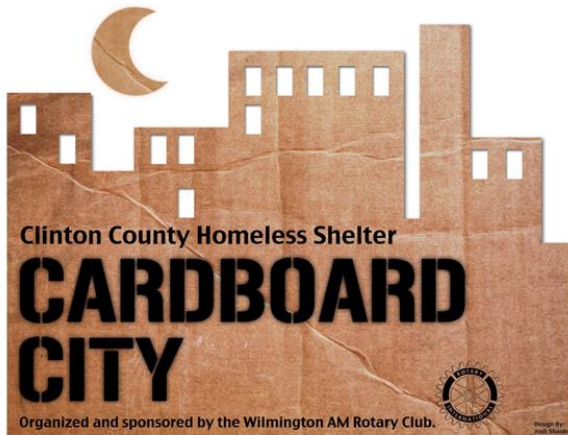

CARDBOARD CITY GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS



Registration is from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
Saturday, September 16, 2017.

Parents or guardians must sign registration form for participants under the age of 18.

All pledge money is due at registration. Checks should be made payable to the Clinton County Homeless Shelter. Bring your sponsorship/Pledge List.

Registration desk is in the large tent on the south lawn of the Clinton County Courthouse.

There must be at least one chaperone for each ten participants.

- One chaperone for each group must be awake at all times.
- Parents or guardians must accompany any child under twelve.
- Wrist bands will be provided for each registered participant. These must be visibly worn at all times.
- Cardboard will be provided (if you don't bring it) to build your home for the night
- Entertainment will be provided until 12 midnight; after which all participants are expected to retire to their respective cardboard houses for the remainder of the event.
- We expect all participants to show courtesy and respect to others.
- No alcohol or drugs will be permitted on the premises. Those who break this rule will be removed from the event.
- No radios, video games, etc.
- Bring a pillow and sleeping bag.
- Wear warm clothing.
- Bring a non-perishable food item to be donated to the Shelter.
- Free soup, sandwiches, hot chocolate, coffee, tea, and water will be provided until 11:00 p.m.
